Welcome back! We hope you have all had a lovely Summer break. We are really looking forward to getting to know you all and starting off a new academic year.

#### Topic

In Autumn 1 our topic is 'How are Antrobus and Pointe-a-Pierre (in Trinidad) the same and different?' We will be identifying and comparing physical and human features of each area. In Autumn 2 we will be learning about The Great Fire of London. We will be learning how the fire began and why the fire spread so quickly, using diary entries from the time to understand what it would have been like.

## Reading

We have started to send home reading books and will continue this over the next few days. These are for you to read and enjoy together and we ask parents to support their children with their reading on a nightly basis. We are introducing 'Strive for Five' in class 2 where the children are encouraged to read five times a week. This will be checked each Thursday and the children will be rewarded with a sticker. Children who are still accessing Phonics will have their books changed weekly on a Thursday. All other children will hand their books in on a Monday and Thursday to be changed if needed.

#### Homework

All children will be set Spelling and Maths homework (Y1 spellings from Autumn 2). Spelling tests will be on a **Friday**. Maths homework will be collected in on a **Monday**. The homework books will be sent out to those who have purchased one as soon as they arrive in school.
